The Fire Service offers free fire alarms and a free home fire check for those over 65 in some areas (contact Fire Service for details). If you would like to book this service call Homesafety on 0800 3890053 or book online.

Other residents may be able to request the free check and alarm if they are a homeowner and on certain benefits or have an elderly person living with them.

- **Gas and oil:** there is no mains gas supply to the parish. Many homes use oil as their main fuel; bottled gas is also used by some properties.

Waste and recycling (kerbside)

Kerbside collection is once a week (Tuesday or Thursday depending on location). Recycling is collected every other week (red & blue wheelie bin lids). General waste (black) is collected on the alternate week. Food waste (brown caddy) is collected weekly. Garden waste (green bin) is collected on recycling weeks between March and November (subscription required via CWaC: [Garden waste collection | Cheshire West and Chester Council](#)).

Shopping

Main supermarkets can be found in Winsford and Northwich. Tarporley has independent shops, bars and places to eat, plus a SPAR and a Co-op. The BP garage on the A49 has a Budgens shop stocking essentials.
